Easter Vacation Programme 2019 – TECHLabs Week

By popular demand, we are pleased to offer ELA Basel children the opportunity to take part in a TECHLab computer, robotics and coding programme during the Easter Vacation Programme.

Children will learn exciting new skills in the following age-appropriate groups:

- Children aged 7-9 will learn about CoSpaces and Physical Programming with Lego + MicroBits. Everybody knows Lego, and we'll take them to a new level of fun and functionality incorporating Micro:Bit computers. Micro:Bit computers are tiny, inexpensive, programmable computers with loads of available buttons, sensors, and other physical inputs and outputs.
- Children aged 10-12 will learn different computer coding activities for example, AR/VR Coding with Google Cardboard. Children will be introduced to the Scratch 3 programming environment, Micro:Bit micro-controller, learn to make Lego and digital technology interact. They will also learn how to design an immersive world in 3D format.

TECHLabs will run age-appropriate groups of up to 8 children each, run by a fully trained and COBIS-accredited instructor. Instructors will also be assisted by our own teaching assistants. The activities will take place over three hours each morning for the four day week. For more information about TECHLabs please see their website: www.techlabs.ch

The cost of the TECHLabs Vacation Programme for children aged 7 and over is CHF 590- which represents excellent value. Please note places are limited and will be offered on a first come first serve basis.

Children aged 4-6 will be offered a variety of ICT experiences, along with arts and crafts and outdoor activities. The cost of the Easter Vacation programme for children aged 4-6 is CHF 460-.

Enrolment Conditions

If you wish your child to attend this 4-day Vacation Programme, please complete the registration form and return it to the office by **Monday 8th April 2019**. You will receive an invoice for the Vacation Programme as soon as your place is confirmed. Please note that spaces for the programme are limited, therefore places will be given on a first-come first-served basis as signed contracts are returned. Once places are filled, a waitlist will be created.

The children must arrive at Gartenstrasse by 8:30 on each day of the programme, however they may be dropped at school from 7:30 onwards and will be supervised until the programme starts. Pick-up is at 15:30 Monday to Thursday, 14:00 on Friday, or between 17:00 and 18:00 Monday to Friday.

Please indicate on the enrolment form which time you will be collecting your child at Gartenstrasse. Attendance is required for the full week of the programme; there are no refunds for non-attendance. The school reserves the right to adapt the programme if circumstances dictate this is necessary.
